

## Directions for larger vehicles: postcode SA38 9NA

(avoids sharp left turn and steepest of hills)

### From the M4/A40

If you are coming from the Midlands or the South, the quickest route is probably to take the M4 right to the end, and then take the A48, to Carmarthen. You will have to pay to cross the Severn Bridge into Wales ((cars & minibuses up to 9 seats:£6.50; minibuses & vans:£13.10 as at October 2015) but it's free on the way back.

The alternative is to follow the A40, which avoids the Severn Bridge toll and provides some amazing scenery, but will probably take longer. You join the route where the A40 joins the Carmarthen by-pass (in green below).

- When you get to Carmarthen on the A48, follow the signs for the **hospital**:
  - 1st roundabout, 3rd exit
  - 2nd roundabout, 3rd exit (2nd exit is a service road - just look for the sign to the hospital if you're unsure)
  - 3rd roundabout, 1st exit **(it is at this roundabout that the A40 joins - you need the 2nd exit on this route).**
  - 4th roundabout, 1st exit (this takes you past the hospital)
  - 5th roundabout, 2nd exit on to **A484** (the sign is for Newcastle Emlyn) (take care - very twisty roads),
- On the A484, at Cynwyl Elfed, pass a restaurant (currently Chinese) and a village store on your right.
  - Go up the hill and take the **B4333** on your **left**, just before the bend.
- On the B4333, go through Hermon and all the way to Newcastle Emlyn (about 10 miles in all). You will reach a T-junction - turn **left** on to the A484
- Follow the A484 for about three quarters of a mile. Just after a pelican pedestrian crossing, turn **left** for Capel Iwan (signposted for Newcastle Leisure Centre).

### From the North

Get onto the A484, which is the main road from Cardigan to Newcastle Emlyn. Look out for a water pump on a small green and a turning on the left called New Road, but don't go down there. Take the next **right** - a sharp turning, just before a pelican pedestrian crossing, (signposted for Newcastle Leisure Centre).

### The rest of the route

- Continue past the leisure centre and keep on this road for about 4 miles. This road can be quite narrow in places.

- After about 4 miles you will negotiate 2 rather tight hairpin bends followed quickly by a T-junction. You must give way and make a **left** turn onto this road.
- After about 400 yards you will pass through a small group of houses (Cwm Cych). Carry straight on up the valley, keeping the river on your right, until you go over a small bridge.
- About 50 yards after the bridge take the next turning on your **left**. This is our road - it is very narrow but there are passing spaces. Continue on this road for about 1 mile, always keeping the river on your left hand side. Look out for a wooden sign for Clwb on your left.

**To get to Park Villa:** When you have passed the sign for Clwb, take the next turn on the **left**. Park Villa is the next house on the **left**, just as you start up the hill again. The parking area is on the **right**, across the road from the house.

**To get to Godremamog Mill:** keep going down the road, without turning off. The river must stay on your left hand side. after a few hundred yards, you will see the water mill on your left hand side.

- Drive past the mill and you will see the entrance to the driveway. Turn **left** into the drive and **right** into the car park (but you might like to go left up to the mill to drop your stuff off first - you can turn round at the top).
